Suggested Retail Minimum Investment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Keystone to 2.5 x cost, depending upon the piece• No specific dollar amount is fixed. Glo works with each customer to determine a minimum based on there being enough pieces to “tell a story” well. A common initial investment amount is \$1000.
Details	<p>The Nuria Ruiz line is actually eleven collections, each based upon the life experiences or changing philosophies of Nuria Ruiz herself. While Glo is the sole US distributor for all eleven collections, there are 8 on which Glo concentrates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Elementos (“The Four Elements”): A very successful collection made in either sterling silver or 18K yellow gold, featuring the symbols for Air, Fire, Water, and Earth. Pendants designed for multiple sales and matching earrings and rings are the best sellers• Mea Vita (“My Life”): Pendants and earrings in sterling silver or 18K gold, signifying such life stages or qualities as Growth, Birth, Maternity, Equilibrium, Harmony and Femininity• Trigrams (“Trigrams”): A geometric collection made in either sterling silver or 18K yellow gold, featuring the Chinese trigram symbols, amongst which Yin and Yang are the most notable. Pendants, earrings, bracelets, rings, cufflinks.• Lianas (“Lines”): Handmade pieces featuring high-quality Akoya or Tahitian pearls and hand-crafted, wires gracefully arching around them. Primarily an 18K collection, with a few pieces available in sterling silver.• Espaguetis (“Spaghetti”): A completely handmade line of 18K gold, for high-end or collector clients primarily.• He She We: Pendants, earrings, and rings crafted in sterling silver or 18K gold, symbolizing the concepts of I, He, She, Couple, We, All.• Diabolos (“Devils”): Munsteiner-cut colored stones and high-quality Tahitian and Akoya pearls accent large, broad domes of hand-finished 18K yellow gold.• Twisting: Bracelets, pendants, rings, and chokers of either sterling silver or 18K gold are graced through hand-crafting with a gentle “twist.” Pieces are either plain matte-finish, or accented with cultured or Tahitian pearls.

Items from the “4 Elements” Collection and the Trigram Collection

Individual Elements pendants vary from \$33 - \$36 cost in sterling silver; and from \$111 - \$233 cost in 18K gold. There are a total of 7 different pendants: two different size of Fire, Earth, and Water; one size of Air.

4 Elements ring is \$100 cost in sterling silver; \$481 in 18K yellow gold.

Yin-Yang Trigram collection earrings are shown in 18K yellow gold, \$394 cost. In sterling silver, \$68 cost.

Trigram pendant is shown in 18K yellow gold, \$146 cost. In sterling silver, \$36 cost.



“Twisting” collar, shown in 18K yellow gold with side hinge and 9.0-9.5mm Akoya pearl, \$2312 cost.
